WHAT IS RESPONSIVE DESIGN?

(The practical definition)

Using the core techniques outlined in the worthless definition above, frameworks and standards have been developed which, if one accepts the default methods of resolving layouts at mobile resolutions, can offer the advantages of responsive design, for only an incremental markup over the cost of only a desktop website.

WHAT IS RESPONSIVE DESIGN?

(The technical, but worthless definition)


Responsive design is a constellation of techniques which were introduced into the language which governs the presentation of text and layout on the web, called CSS (Cascading Style Sheets.) The two most commonly leveraged techniques in responsive design include:

- The ability to use 'media queries' to offer layout alternatives for web pages or apps, based on the resolution (and a few other arcane factors) of the browsing device
- The ability to resize images dynamically, using either CSS techniques or JavaScript



There is a misunderstanding among some marketers that the flexibility of responsive techniques are 'automatic.' In fact, for custom work, all responsive design has to be thoughtfully layed out, which requires many times the layouts previously asked of the design firm.

GOOGLE'S 2015 MOBILE ALGORITHM

Google's 2015 algorithm change began evaluating a site's relative <u>mobile friendliness</u>. Sites deemed <u>'mean to mobile'</u> suffer ranking penalties from within mobile search environments.

Google's algorithm looks, specifically, for the hall-marks of a site built using responsive techniques, including the Meta tag, 'Viewport.'
